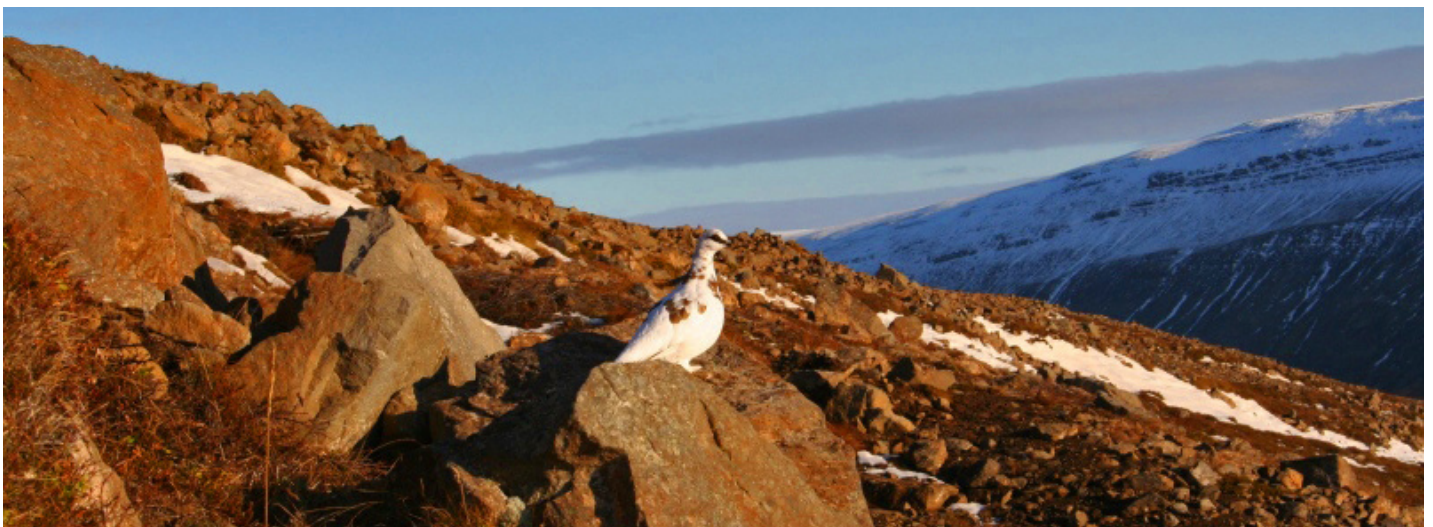

Airport. 3 hunting days and 3 nights full board and lodging, private room to each gun – guiding - 4WD vehicle - our best shooting areas - All licenses and documents allowing you to shoot in Iceland and to take your guns and ammunition through custom - Certificates needed to take your birds out of the country - Iceland VAT.

Price does not include: Flights to Reykjavík - Tips - Gun rental is €70 / day (Benelli) Cartridges are €32/per box of 25 – Alcoholic drinks - Overnight stay in Reykjavik.

Terms & Conditions:

We need a minimum of 4 guns for this special trips. At the time of booking, a 50% deposit is required to confirm dates. Balance shall be paid 90 days before the shooting.



SCHEDULE

Program Geese Hunting:

10th November: Welcoming at the international airport in Iceland. Driving to Reykjavík and make a short stop at hunting store if needed. Departure from Reykjavík and arrive at the Geese Lodge (1 h).

11th – 13th November: 3 full days of no limit Geese shooting. Leave the lodge late afternoon of the 13th Nov. and travel back to a Hotel in Reykjavik.

14th November: After the breakfast our driver takes you to the international airport for departure back home.

If you are joining the Combo trip, we are leaving the Geese shooting in the afternoon of the 13th and drive to the Ptarmigan Lodge (2.5 h).

Program Ptarmigan Hunting:

13th November: Welcoming at the international airport in Iceland. Driving to Reykjavík and make a short stop at hunting store if needed. Departure from Reykjavík around noon, arrive at the Ptarmigan Lodge. (1.5 h)

14th – 16th November: 3 full days of walked up shooting on Ptarmigan with lunch in the field. Leave the lodge late afternoon of the 16th Nov. and travel back to a Hotel in Reykjavik.

17th November: After the breakfast our driver takes you to the international airport for departure back home.



THE SHOOTING



Iceland is one of Europe's most important breeding and stopover regions for several species of geese, including Greylag, Pinkfoot and Barnacle. This unique position on the migratory flyway makes the island one of the continent's finest destinations for world-class goose shooting.



Our partner offers exclusive access to the best cornfields on Iceland's south coast around Gunnarsholt, as well as newly secured prime shooting grounds on the west coast in Melasveit. Both areas lie at the heart of the main territories for Greylag and Pinkfoot geese, with strong numbers of Barnacle geese arriving from Greenland as well. Hunters shoot from underground blinds with expertly arranged decoy spreads.



More and more hunters are discovering the thrill of pursuing Iceland's "white grouse," the Ptarmigan — widely regarded as one of the most exciting and challenging wingshoots in the world.

The season is short, running from 1 November to 30 November (to be confirmed each year). Good physical fitness is necessary, as much of the hunt takes place on foot across steep hills, valleys and high mountain slopes in search of these iconic birds.



As winter progresses, snowfall drives the birds down into the lower valleys and birch scrub. Although walking is still required, the terrain becomes gentler and less demanding than in the season's early weeks.

ACCOMMODATION
