KING & COMMON EIDER HUNTING GREENLAND - 2026

We offer 2 different areas, one in the south of Greenland in the Nuuk area. The second area is a bit further north of the Arctic Circle in Sisimiut.

The hunt in Nuuk is a more “civilized” hunt from a big city with lots of restaurants and bars – and very cozy accommodation. We can hunt there from beginning of February till end of April.

The area in Sisimiut is a more adventurous hunt in open water and around little island sometimes with open zodiacs for an easy approach to the little islands. Here we hunt only from mid-March till end of April, In February and beginning of March we still have too much ice in the water.

4 NIGHT & 3 HUNTING DAYS PACKAGE (King & Common Eider Duck)

INCLUDED: Transport from the airports Nuuk or Sisimiut to the shooting area and back - 4 night half board and lodging , private room to each gun – Guiding - Warm boats All licenses and documents allowing you to shoot in Greenland and to take your guns and ammunition through customs - Certificates needed to take your birds out of the country - Greenland VAT.

NOT INCLUDED: Flights to Greenland - Tips - Gun rental and cartridges - Dinners & Alcoholic drinks - Overnight stay in Reykjavik.

GROUP SIZE: In Nuuk we can host groups of 2 or 4 hunters – in Sisimiut we have groups with 6 hunters. If you are a single gun or a smaller group, we will try to add you to another smaller group. We are quite flexible and can host any number of hunters – just let us know what you need.

To confirm the booking, we need a down payment of 50% of the total amount. The balance is due 90 days before arrival.



SCHEDULE:

Day 1: Welcoming at your arrival at the airport in Nuuk / Sisimiut and transfer to the Lodge / Hotel.

Day 2 - 4: A typical hunting day starts after a hearty breakfast at 9.00. We drive to the marina, to leave a few minutes later by boat. The aim is to stay on the sea hunting the entire day to be back in the marina at 17:00 hour. Then our driver will take you direct from the Marina to the guesthouse. We will have packed lunch to enjoy on board, sandwiches, chocolate bars and chips, water still and sparkling, tea and coffee. In the evenings you enjoy the different restaurants and bars in Nuuk or Sisimiut.

Day 5: After the breakfast our driver takes you to the airport for departure back home.

THE HUNT:

In Nuuk we have 3 boats (1-25 ft Targa's and 1-37 ft) with fully enclosed, heated cabs. In Sisimiut we have one Targa 1-37ft. The group size will determine which boat is taken each day. The goal is to do 2 to 3 decoys sets per day from rock outcroppings/ islands in the path of trading Eiders. Your guide will determine where the sets will be made as you arrive in Eider country. These sets will be done over a decoy spread of 12-20 decoys and last roughly 60-90 minutes each time. Guests are also welcome to stay on the boat and hunt right from the big boat if the elements are too much. After each set, you will relocate to another area rich in Eiders and repeat.

AVAILABLE BIRDS:

We have mostly Eiders (King Eider and Common Eider) in Greenland, there is also Mallards and sometimes Long Tail Duck (but we don't hunt them often – the population is too vulnerable) – but the hunting period for Mallards and Long Tail Duck ends end of February so if you want to hunt these species also, you have to come in February...

THE ARCTIC FOUR – GREENLAND MULTI-SPEZIES HUNT:

This is a combo hunt on 1 Reindeer, 1 Arctic fox, 1 Arctic hare, 5 Ptarmigan and 5 King Eider. The hunt includes 5 hunting days and 6 nights in Nuuk. We are hunting in the mountains and fjords of Nuuk. So far we have a success rate of 100% on all trophies. This combo hunt is available from 15 Feb to 10 of April.

COMBO HUNT WITH MUSK OX:

We have an option to add a Musk Ox hunt to the King Eider in Sisimiut. You fly into Kangerlussuaq and hunt the Musk ox first (4 day hunt) you then take a flight to Sisimiut and hunt the King Eider (3 day hunt). So far we have a success rate of 100% on both trophies. This combo hunt is only available in March and beginning of April.

Package price is 14.000 € - please come back to me for more detailed information.

BIRD LIMITS:

The average bag per group and day in the last year was around 3-8 King Eider and up to 25 common Eider... (The limit on Eiders in Greenland is 10 per gun per day; it doesn't matter if it is Kings or Commons. Please understand that this will not be the goal each time we go afield! This resource is too precious and fragile to take that many birds, and we will not do it. If that is your goal or you disagree with us on this self-induced restriction, please book somewhere else...)

BRINGING BIRDS HOME:

You have the choice to have your capes sent to a taxidermist in Denmark, where they can be dipped, packed and sent onwards to a taxidermist of your choice or mounted there and sent to you. The price to ship your birds to Denmark is 200 €. (Up to 20 birds can be send).

You can also take the frozen vacuum-packed capes with you in your luggage at your own risk. We have a service agent in Nuuk that will prepare the birds and pack them for 325 DKK (ca. 37US\$) per bird. For that purpose, please send us your address, in order for us to make a certificate of origin for you. (Please understand that this might need 3-4 days after the hunt.)

You may encounter problems with bringing the birds yourself into Iceland IF you cannot check your luggage all the way back home from Greenland. Necessary vet certificates are only issued in Denmark once the trophies get there, and Iceland requires a vet certificate. If you plan to spend time in Iceland we advise you to have your birds sent to Denmark.
