The full-time service of a licensed Professional Hunter and complete field and lodge staff and services - Full board and lodging of three meals a day including laundry - Pick up and drop off at East London Airport - All ground transport during the safari with fully kitted hunting vehicles - All birds shot and cleaning of birds - South African wine, beer and spirits, within reason - Gun dogs, decoys, bird boys and blinds - Hunting License - VAT.

Graduits - Gun Import (POR) - Ammunition - Hire of shotguns @ 60-80 US\$ / day
Specially requested alcohol - Hotels & Flights before and after the hunt.

Terms & Conditions:

We need a minimum of 4 guns for this special trip. At the time of booking, a 50% deposit is required to confirm dates. Balance shall be paid 90 days before the shooting.



Absolute Hunting & Wingshooting

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SCHEDULE

1st Day - Johannesburg Int. Airport - Freestate

Arrive at OR Tambo airport. Clear firearms. Met by PHs at airport. Travel to the Lodge in the Freestate (1.5 h) - Check in & Dinner.

2nd & 3rd Day - Freestate

Breakfast and drive to the Pigeon and Dove fields for a full day of high-volume shooting. Lunch to be taken in the field. Return late evening for dinner.

4th Day - Freestate

One full days of driven and walked up hunting on Guinea fowl and Francolin. Coming back in the night - drinks and dinner.

5th Day - Travel Day to Zululand - 4-5 hours with lunch in between.

6th & 7th Day - Zululand

High volume decoyed Duck & Geese shooting. We will have 2 outings per day with a nice rest in the middle of the day. Coming back after dawn - drinks and dinner.

Ninth Day – Tambacounda to Dakar

Early breakfast. Depart back to Johannesburg (4-5 hours).



BIRDSHOOTING IN SOUTH AFRICA



Duck Shooting

High-volume decoyed duck shoots take place from comfortable dry blinds set near water—no waders needed. Early afternoons bring wave after wave of Yellow-billed Ducks and Red-billed Teal flighting into their roosting ponds. Expect 10–20 ducks per gun per shoot, with fast action and beautiful birds.



Goose Shooting

Goose shoots are conducted from screen blinds or lay-in blinds on harvested corn fields, over large decoy spreads. The impressive Spurwing Goose, one of the world's largest, can weigh nearly 20 pounds. When a flock of more than 100 birds swings in, the thunder of their wings is truly unforgettable. Expect around 10 geese per gun per shoot.



Dove & Pigeon Shooting

Hot-barrel dove shooting takes place in sunflower and sorghum fields, along treelines, or in natural draws. The African Turtle Dove—famously described as “the most challenging game bird in the world”—will test even the best shots with its unpredictable angles and sudden turns.



Guinea Fowl

Driven guinea fowl shoots are a uniquely South African experience. More than 20 chanting Zulu beaters drive the birds in a style reminiscent of the legendary “bull-horn” formation of Shaka Zulu. Francolin and partridge are hunted over skilled pointing dogs, offering traditional and highly enjoyable walked-up shooting.

ACCOMMODATION & GUN IMPORT



Accommodation

Depending of the area the time of the year, we are using different private Lodges. They are all renowned for their warm hospitality, the exceptional service and gourmet cuisine and the spacious and luxurious accommodation. After a solid day's shooting, the Lodges can be a welcome sight for the weary and cold hunter, where fond memories of the day's shooting can be re-lived around the large stone fireplace in the entertainment room. Hosting, fine wine and dining is the order of the day.



Gun Clearance, Guns and Ammunition

If you choose to bring your own gun & shotgun, you will be required to have a Temporary Import Permit upon your arrival in South Africa at customs for gun clearance. We use Africa Sky for this purpose. The Temporary Import Permits application will be sent to you by Africa Sky well in advance for you to fill in and return. They will meet you upon arrive and guide you through the process of clearing your gun. This is well worth the extra cost and saves time and hassle. We also use Africa Sky for accommodation before or after your safari.



If you would rather hire a shotgun from us, we do have a variety of 12g & 20g OU shotguns and semi automatic available. Excellent, imported 12 and limited 20 gauge is available. We supply imported shotgun shells from Italy, Spain and Czechoslovakia (e.g. Fiocchi, Nobel Sport, Clever) between 7 1/2 -3's depending on the species.



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
